

Camp One Gym U14 Boulder Hungarian Cup event, October 5th, 2024

Basedata

Location: 7623 Pécs, Megyeri road 4. Camp 1 Gym (it is in a small industrial park, through the barrier next to Professors Gym follow the road to the back of the industrial park)

Date: October 5th, 2024.

Age categories

Mini (U10): born between 2015 and 2017

Child (U12): born in 2013 or 2014

Teenage (U14): born in 2011 or 2012

Rules

General rules

Camp One Gym Boulder Hungarian Cup is organized in accordance with the rules set out in the Competition Rules of the Hungarian Mountaineering and Sport Climbing Federation (MHSSZ with a few modifications.

Special house rule

Because of safety concerns – during rounds – climbers and judges are permitted on the boulder mats, only.

Qualifier rounds

The following qualifier rounds will be held:

- Mini (U10),
- Child (U12),
- Teenage (U14)

Depending on the number of competitors registering to the event, there could be one or two starting groups organized for Mini (U10), Child (U12), Teenage (U14) age categories.

(Competitors of each starting group within one qualifier round climb the same boulders, i.e, starting groups start at different times!)

All starting groups are limited to a maximum of 30 participants.

Format: The format is jam for all qualifiers.

Number of boulders: All qualifiers have 10 boulders each

Climbing time: Climbing time is 90 minutes for all qualifiers. (To be precise, in the qualifiers, when the climbing time is over, no competitor can start a new trial. Yet, whoever has started climbing before the time was out and is still in a legitimate position when the time runs out, may complete the given boulder.)

Number of allowed trials: Competitors of Mini (U10), Child (U12) categories have unlimited number of trials for each boulder, Teenage (U14) competitors have a maximum of 8 trials for each boulder.

Qualifier round ranking

The ranking of the qualifier round is calculated according to known IFSC rules, i.e. taking into account the scores of each competitor in the following precedence order

- number of tops (the more, the better),
- number of zones (the more, the better),
- number of top trials (the less, the better),
- number of zone trials (the less, the better).

Final results for age categories:

For Mini (U10), Child (U12) age categories the final result is based on the ranking of the qualifier round.

For Teenage(U14) there will be a Final round held.

The Final round of the Teenage(U14) category

Who qualifies to the Final round?

All competitors

- having valid Hungarian competition license (an MHSSZ – Hungarian Mountaineering and Sport Climbing Federation – membership card for the calendar year AND medical check valid at the time of the competition), OR
- foreign competitors without valid Hungarian competition license but with valid status in their respective IFSC member country,

are eligible to qualify.

As a rule of thumb, for each gender, based on the ranking for the qualification round, maximum 50 percent of the starters (rounded up), or the first 8 competitors qualify, whichever restriction applies first, with the following clarifications:

- If a Hungarian competitor who is not eligible to qualify ranks among the first eight in the qualification round, no competitor outside of the first eight can take his or her place.
- If there is a tie on the 8th place in the qualification round, all tied competitors qualify.
- If one or more foreign competitors without valid Hungarian competition license qualify to the Final round, if available, an equal number of competitors from 9th or lower positions with valid Hungarian competition license must be added to the list of competitors of the Final round.

Format: is basically IFSC compliant with one significant difference: the climbing time cycle is 5 minutes. I.e.:

- 4 boulders,
- “onsight” format (competitors start from isolation),
- unlimited number of trials within the climbing time,
- competitors on the first boulder start in the reverse order of their ranking from the qualification round (the least ranked competitor starts first),
- 5 minutes climbing time followed by 5 minutes rest time followed by next 5 minutes climbing time on the second boulder, and so on...

Registration:

Registration deadline is 2024 October 3rd 23:59

Registration fee: 6000 HUF

You may change your starting group at <https://vr.mhssz.hu> till the registration deadline.

By registering to the event you accept the house rules, the disclaimer, the privacy statement and the competition rules.

By default, registration fee should be wire transferred.

Please note, that

- **if a parent of a Hungarian competitor fails to pay by wire transfer in advance or on site, and would like to pay cash at the venue, an extra 2000 HUF is charged,**
- **at the venue credit/bank card payments are not permitted for the purpose of settling registration fee!!!**

Foreign teams registering multiple competitors to the event may pay in cash lump sum during on-site registration / check-in (without extra charge).

Some useful info about the registration process / our VR system:

Competitors must have an account at <https://vr.mhssz.hu/>.

If this is your very first time to register to a Hungarian Cup event, you must create an account first by clicking the green Registration button on the Dashboard and by providing necessary data for the registration form that follows. Once the account is created the system sends out a verification link via e-mail to the provided e-mail address. You must click this link to complete the registration process.

After verification, you may log in, and register to the event on the event page.

Please note the following:

Both account name and password are case sensitive

Make sure, you provide valid e-mail address during the registration process, otherwise the e-mail with the verification link will never reach you, therefore you will not be able to log in.

Make sure, you provide valid date of birth during the registration process, otherwise you may end up in the wrong age group, and you will not be able to apply for a new password if you end up forgetting the old. (To start the Forgotten password process you must provide the account name AND the date of birth as recorded in the system, and the system will send a time limited link to the registered e-mail address of the account. If you fail to provide the correct account name and date of birth, no e-mail is sent out.)

Preliminary schedule

Saturday

Mini (U10), Child (U12), Teenage (U14) age categories

As a starter, we have scheduled one starting group for U10, one for U12, and two for U14, but only opened the first U14 starting group for registration purposes.

Please note, this may change depending on the number of competitors registering to this event. If starting times change, we will announce that on the VR Web site and will send an e-mail to all effected, too.

08:00 registration starts

09:00-10:30 Mini (U10) starting group

11:15 Award ceremony for U10

11:30-13:00 Child (U12) starting group 1

13:45 Award ceremony for U12

14:00-15:30 Teenage (U14) starting group 1.

15:45-17:15 Optional Teenage (U14) starting group 2.

Isolation for Final round for Teenage (U14) category is expected 30 minutes after completion of last Teenage(U14) starting group.

Climbing in the Final round for Teenage (U14) category is expected to start 60 minutes after completion of last Teenage (U14) starting group.

Please note, this is a preliminary schedule! The organizers reserve the right to make changes to this preliminary schedule based on number of registered competitors.

Awards

The first six competitors of each category shall receive a certificate of achievement, the first three competitors of each category shall receive medals.

Everyone taking part in the competition shall receive at least a certificate of participation.
